* POSITION SUMMARY:

This position will be responsible for leading the Manugistics technical tasks, demand, fulfillment and supply planning processes. This position will eventually own the development, specification and communication of technology architecture plan, infrastructure components and footprint required to support it, and integrations of corporate business systems: KW, IMREX, PRISM, and SAS. This position will lead a technical team to ensure system uptime, troubleshooting production issues, develop feature enhancements, and provide environments for various business activities.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

I. Ensure system uptime:

Implement processes and procedures for development, testing, and deployment that minimize downtime risk while efficiently introduce new features to meet ever changing business needs. Monitor weekend batch jobs and troubleshoot when issues occur.

II. Perform architecture activities, including preparing architectural design, analyzing technology trends, and planning migration path:

Own and manage technical footprint, interfaces to other business systems, dev/test/prod resource management, long term system and version planning and execution, interface with IT counterparts.

III. Manage development resource

Often times contingent resources are required in order to meet the business requirements as soon as possible. This role will prioritize enhancement requests with business owners, assign tasks/projects to development resources, and manage development resources to deliver results according to plan and budget.

IV. Manage resource to support business activities

Plan with DBAs on current and future MANU instance needs, ensure sufficient instances available to support AOP, projects, and other ad hoc requests.
